IFPEN's 2021 Activity Report has just been published. Focusing on ecological transition, it looks back on a year of commitments and key events for the energy transition.

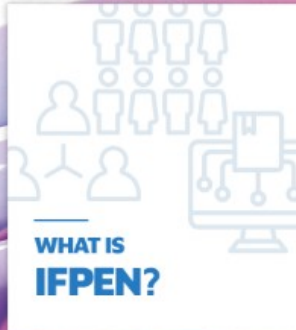
